Grape variety: Pinot Noir

Robe: Ruby

Nose: Bouquet of red fruits with spicy notes

Palate: Wines with silky tannins, a concentrated wine with a beautiful acidity and a beautiful length.

Storage time: 5 to 10 years

Food and wine pairing: Red meat in sauce or a powerful cheese such as Époisses.

Origins:

This Savigny les Beaune rouge comes from one of the 22 1er Crus of the village of Savigny les Beaune. "Les Peuillets" is located on a clayey-limestone terroir similar to the biggest Crus of Burgundy wines.

The Estate:

The estate is located in the south of the Côte de Beaune, in Change (21340). A family estate for 5 generations, we now cultivate 60 hectares of vines in the following appellations: Hautes Côtes de Beaune, Santenay, Maranges and Savigny les Beaune.
