WINEMAKING



Manual grape harvest and grape-by-grape selection on the sorting table. Cold maceration and fermentation for 8 days. Aged for 24 months in new French oak barrels selected from various cooperages. Further refinement in the bottle.

TASTING NOTE



It has a brick-red garnet color with a high and consistent layer. It offers aromas of very ripe fruit, almost candied or in liqueur, creamy oak, fine cocoa, aromatic coffee, mineral notes, and balsamic nuances. On the palate, it is full-bodied, voluminous, structured, with mature tannins, and a long-lasting finish.

FOOD PAIRING



Perfect for roast dishes, stews or complex meats. It is also ideal for long after-dinner conversations with nuts and dark chocolate.

Reserva Martí is a wine that we have been producing since 1994, the year Martí Albet i Esteve was born, the fifth generation of winemakers at Can Vendrell, to whom the wine is dedicated. It is a very careful selection of the best grapes of the estate and the finest cooperages in the world, with a personal commitment to craft a great ageing wine for the most memorable occasions. It is one of the most award-winning and recognized wines from the cellar.
