OVERVIEW

Way back in 1740, Louis XV said Joseph-Marie de Ségur Cabanac was the richest Lord in his Kingdom: "in on lands suitable for producing nectar and diamonds". The considerable esteem in which wines of Bessan Ségur were held led to a whole dynasty of aristocrats scrambling to own it. Bessan Ségur therefore saw itself headed by a succession of names such as the d'Augeard, de Basterot, Vertamont, Saint Cyr Mortier, Werteimer and then, after the Second World War, Marcel Andron, the granffather of the current owner, Rémi Lacombe. For more than 20 years, he and his team are dedicated to the glory of this jewel of the peninsular.

MAKING PROCESS

Classical vinification in thermo-regulated stainless steel vats. Cold maceration. Ageing in barrels, with 35% to 100% new barrels.

TASTING NOTE

Deep brilliant garnet colour. The bouquet is full of ripe fruits, blackcurrant and wild strawberries with touches of undergrowth scents. Fine complexity. Supple and silky on the palate with a lonf-lasting finish.
