

CH HAUT PAUILLAC - 2012

PAUILLAC AOC

OVERVIEW

Located next to the village of Pauillac, the plots of Château Haut Pauillac benefit from a quality soil between the best classified growths of the appellation of Pauillac, Château Mouton Rothschild, Château Lynch Bages, Château Pichon Baron de Longueville. Château Haut-Pauillac belongs to the Peyronie family, the owner of the famous Château Fonbadet Cru Bourgeois, for several generations.

VINEYARD

Soil: Gravels from the Garonne River.

Surface: 2 ha

Location: The vineyard is located in the commune of Pauillac.

Average age of vineyards: 50 years

Grape Varieties: 15% Cabernet Franc / 60% Cabernet Sauvignon / 20% Merlot /

3% Petit Verdot / 2% Malbec

MAKING PROCESS

Sustained vineyard management. Classical vinification in concrete vats covered with epoxy. Temperature control. Running after maceration of 28 to 35 days. Ageing for 18 months in barrels, with 15-20% new oak.

TASTING NOTE

This vintage displays deep and bright garnet colour. The nose develops aromas of black fruits (cherry, blackberry) supported by well-integrated oaky notes. The palate is round and supple with silky and pleasant structure. Well-balanced and elegant wine.

AGEING POTENTIAL: From 5 to 10 years
