Origin

Why the name “Fuchsentanz” (“Fox Dance”)? It was inspired by the German expression which directly translates to “where Fox and Rabbit say goodnight”, in other words, a remote place out in the sticks. Though not a vineyard designation, Fuchsentanz is the name long associated with our most approachable Riesling. The grapes grow predominantly on loess soils, which provide the perfect foundation for the fresh, elegant style of Riesling we aim for.

Character

Juicy freshness, a touch of residual sugar (3–4 g/l) to balance the lively acidity, and plenty of fruit make Fuchsentanz a charming wine that delights even in its youth. Yet it remains unmistakably Diwald: multifaceted, authentic, and a true reflection of its origin.
