Origins:

Santenay is an old village dominated by the mountain of the 3 crosses. It produces an area of 330 hectares of vines, 85% of which are typical red wines (powerful and full-bodied). The whites are rather dry and fine with a natural minerality similar to the neighbouring village of Chassagne-Montrachet

The Estate:

The estate is located in the south of the Côte de Beaune, in Change (21340). A family estate for 5 generations, we now cultivate 60 hectares of vines in the following appellations: Hautes Côtes de Beaune, Santenay, Maranges and Savigny les Beaune.
