TASTING NOTES

An intensely red wine with aromas and flavors of violets, plums, cherries, red fruits and black pepper. It boasts firm and round tannins, a medium-to-high body, and a very fruity character. Great balance between alcohol and freshness.

PAIRING AND SERVING SUGGESTIONS

It is perfect to pair with grilled meats, stuffed pasta, risottos, and hard or mature cheeses. Best served at 18° C (64° F).

VINEYARDS

The grapes are sourced from three different selected blocks, which confers different characteristics to the wine. The blocks are located as follows: one in La Consulta (San Carlos, Uco Valley), which offers floral aromas, sweet flavors of red fruits and color intensity. The second is in Los Árboles (Tunuyán, Uco Valley) and confers mineral notes that translate into a refreshing feel. Finally, the third block is in Agrelo (Luján de Cuyo) and contributes structured and subtly elegant fruity flavors. The art of blending these three blocks ultimately renders a complex and balanced wine.

WINEMAKING CHARACTERISTICS

The wine is aged for 12 months in French oak barrels (80% of the wine) and American oak barrels (20% of the wine).
