Etern means eternal. Priorat sloping hills vineyards are eternal because they are so tough, deep and spiritual it seems they will be alive forever.

This wine comes from a selection of beautiful and exceptional sloping hills old vineyards from 70 to 95 years old in the Priorat region. They are very low yield vineyard, only 300 to 700 grams per vine production.

As the philosophy of RITME CELLER this wine is based only on native, indigenous varieties 80% Carinyena and 20% Garnatxa. Only 2.274 bottles of production.

The wine is aged 12 months in new Allier low toasted French oak barrels from the best selection of the Tonnellerie.

Bottled in January 2017.

TASTING NOTES:

Stephan Tanzer's Tasting notes:

(aged in new French oak barrels for one year): Inky ruby. A complex bouquet evokes vibrant dark berry, incense and potpourri, along with smoky minerals and candied licorice. The concentrated, sharply focused palate reveals bitter cherry and cassis flavors that spread out and sweeten in the glass. Densely packed yet lithe, with superb finishing clarity and harmonious tannins that fold smoothly into the wine's intense fruit. Reportedly produced from 70- to 95-year-old vines.
