Château VIRCOULON 2020 BORDEAUX BLANC

OVERVIEW

Château Vircoulon has been a family property for four generations. Originally producing many different crops when Patrick Hospital took it over in 1983, he turned it over entirely to wine-growing. Nowadays, he manages the property with his wife.

VINEYARD

Soil: 80% loamy-sand and 20% chalky-clay Surface: 4 hectares Location: The vineyard, South/South-West facing, is located in Saint-Avitde-Soulège close to Castillon-La-Bataille. Average age of the vineyard: 20 years Grape varieties: 50% Sauvignon Blanc / 30% Sémillon / 20% Muscadelle

MAKING PROCESS

Low temperature vinification after 10 days at cold temperature on deposits from the must. In thermo-regulated tanks at low temperature

TASTING NOTE

Beautiful clear yellow colour with golden hints. The bouquet reveals citrus fruits and white flowers notes. This wine is well-balanced with fruity aromas and a good liveliness on the finish.

MATCHING FOOD

Serve at 12-14°C. This wine will be ideal with a grilled sea bream or a sole meunière. It will also be perfect on soft cheeses....
