

CHATEAU LARY LACOMBE

2024 - BORDEAUX BLANC SAUVIGNON

OVERVIEW

This family wine farm is located at 50 kilometres to the South-East of Bordeaux and 10 kilometres from La Réole, on the Entre-deux-Mers area. It is in this region that the Queen of England, Aliénor d'Aquitaine, had the first vines planted in 1150. In 1850 the domain was bought by Angelo Forcato. From 1960, Angelo's son Aron and his grandsons started to expand and modernize it, while still respecting tradition. Today, Serge takes over part of the estate and produces a wine under the name Château Lary Lacombe located on the lands of Saint-Vivien de Monségur.

VINEYARD

Soil: Clay-limestone

Location: The vineyard is located on the slopes of the North bank of the Garonne River, on the Entre-deux-Mers plateau. South-facing area, enjoying strong summer sunshine.

Surface: 35 ha

Average age of vineyards: 22 years

WINEMAKING PROCESS

Classical wine-making.

TASTING NOTES

Attractive light and bright colour. Typical nose of citrus fruits and box tree notes. The palate is in the same aromatic shade with fine volume and an excellent freshness on the finish.

PAIRING

This wine goes perfectly with a variety of dishes. It's the perfect accompaniment to seafood, grilled fish, summer salads and fresh goat's cheese. For a vegetarian option, it pairs well with grilled vegetable dishes or vegetable quiches.
