## BAIGORRI Belus 2015

Thanks to the large proportion of the variety Mazuelo to this red field blend, it is quite unlike any other BAIGORRI wine - a new dimension for wines from Rioja. A new definition of freshness and elegance in a red wine; fine-grained tannins combine with great aromatic complexity, refreshing and subtle on the palate.

Pure avant-garde – that's Rioja too!

Red field blend made from the varieties **Mazuelo** (70%), **Tempranillo** (15%) and **Garnacha** (15%), sourced from old vines (>65 years).

After a manual picking, all the grapes are hand-selected, berry per berry, using vibration and selection tables. The destalked and uncrushed grapes macerate in oak fermenters. Long intracellular fermentations with indigenous yeasts. Natural extraction by gravity. Malolactic fermentation and **14 months** ageing in new French oak barrels of different sizes (225l. / 500l. / 600l.).

## Vineyards

One plot located at an altitude of 700 meters, with a ferruginous calcareous clay soil. Vine training system: *Gobelet* (bush vine system). Sustainable viticulture with 100% handcraft.
