

# Hautes Côtes de Beaune

Regional AOC

Burgundy

Grape variety: Pinot Noir

Robe: Purple and purplish colour

Nose: Fresh with red fruit notes coupled with fine toasted notes

Palate: Beautiful freshness and silky tannins, fine and elegant wine with a slightly spicy finish

Storage time: 3 to 5 years for the best vintages.

Food and wine pairing: Ideal as an aperitif or for a "mâchon" such as a Burgundy plateau where you can enjoy mix of delicatessen, cheese and gougère.

## Origins:

The Hautes Côtes de Beaune appellation extends over some thirty kilometres from Beaune to the Maranges valley. The appellation has taken its rightful place in the panorama of the Burgundy regional AOC. Its wines (white and red) have a lot of fruit and have made great progress while remaining at reasonable prices.

## The Estate:

The estate is located in the south of the Côte de Beaune, in Change (21340). A family estate for 5 generations, we now cultivate 60 hectares of vines in the following appellations: Hautes Côtes de Beaune, Santenay, Maranges and Savigny les Beaune.
