MONTAGNE SAINT EMILION

OVERVIEW

Château Gadenne is owned by the same family for 150 years. This property is today managed by Mrs Jean-Marie Gadenne. The estate of Château Gadenne is located on the ancient commune of Parsac and is one of the oldest properties in the area, as testifies the arched cellar from the 18th century. This cellar overlooks the vines and pond. From its valley we can admire all the North of Saint-Emilion. The estate was taken over by Pierre Musset in 1887 and then passed down from one generation to the next. Mrs Jean-Marie Gadenne is the great-granddaughter of Pierre Musset. The château is still a family-place where members enjoy meet each other.

VINEYARD

Soil: Clay and chalky-clay

Surface: 7 hectares

Average age of the vineyard: 35 years

Grape varieties: 80% Merlot / 15% Cabernet Franc / 5% Cabernet Sauvignon

VINIFICATION

Classical vinification in thermo-regulated concrete vats. Maceration for 8 to 18 days. Ageing for 12 months in concrete vats (80%) and barrels (20%).

WINE TASTING

This vintage displays nice purple colour. The bouquet is fruity and generous. The attack is supple and smooth, and gives way to a fleshy and aromatic wine. Pleasant thin tannins.

MATCHING FOOD AND WINE

Serve at 71-18°C with roast rack of lamb in herb crust, or with beef tenderloin and morels, along with seasonal vegetables. This wine will be perfect with a good selection of cheeses.
